is the only NO-KILL, non-profit, cat rescue organization on Maui that maintains a sanctuary for those kitties that have no other place to safely stay.

Some of our rescues are disabled cats, kittens and cats from colonies that have been under attack by humans or dogs. Other kitties have been dumped in the cane fields that are routinely set on fire as part of the harvesting process. All will remain at one of our sanctuaries until a loving home is found.

We are also caretakers at cat colonies where we utilize trap, neuter, release (TNR) to humanely reduce the cat population. When possible the cats are returned to their colonies and our volunteer caretakers continue to monitor the colonies and provide regular supplies of food, water and medication.

Crystal began rescuing cats in 1985 when she noticed the huge population of homeless cats on Maui.
