"In the last decade and a half, shelters in numerous communities have comprehensively implemented a bold series of programs collectively referred to as the "No Kill Equation." The fundamental lesson (learned) is that the choices made by shelter managers are the most significant variables in whether animals live or die.

Several communities are more than doubling adoptions and cutting killing as much as 75% and it isn't taking them five years or more to do it. They are doing it virtually overnight. They are achieving unprecedented results, saving upwards of 95% of all impounded animals in <u>open</u> admission animal control facilities." *

9th Life Hawaii believes if other communities can successfully achieve a No Kill municipal shelter in their community, we can do the same on Maui. If you abhor the fact that more than 70% of cats and more than 60% of dogs do NOT make it out alive from Maui Humane Society, then it's time to demand change from our elected officials.

Our tax dollars fund more than one half of the revenue it takes to run the Maui Humane Society. It's time to demand leadership that will embrace No Kill and work actively toward that goal. Enough killing! It hasn't worked in the past 50 years on Maui and it's not going to work in the next 50 years.

Demand our tax dollars be spent on free and affordable spay/neuter services. Demand change.

If you haven't read Nathan Winograd's book "Redemption, the Myth of Pet Overpopulation and the No Kill Revolution in America", we urge you to do so. If you love animals and you want to end the systematic killing of animals in our nation's community pounds and shelters, this is a must-read book.
