### Another Life Saved by Your Donations

Tulip's owner had passed on and she was left to roam the neighborhood where they had lived. Gone were the daily feedings and supply of fresh water. She was truly abandoned. She did not know how to hunt and likely would not have lived long. Ultimately, she was either caught or trapped and brought to the Maui Humane Society who traced her tattoo to the person who had her spayed for Tulip's owner years ago. That person just happened to be a board member of 9<sup>th</sup> Life Hawaii. We picked up Tulip from the Maui Humane Society, where she had roughly a 25% chance of making it out alive. She had been at 9<sup>th</sup> Life for about one year when lo and behold, she caught the eye of the people who adopted her recently. It is the donations we receive from donors like you that allow us to save these precious lives. As a No Kill facility, Tulip would have been safe here at 9<sup>th</sup> Life for the rest of her life, however we are thrilled that she was adopted by such a loving family. What follows is Deneen's letter about both Tulip and Heather (also adopted from 9<sup>th</sup> Life.)

"Just wanted you to see the ladies are settling in. We love them so much already! We were excited and happy they came out of hiding and slept with us on Saturday night (adoption day). We love how much love and attention they give us! They seem happy and content and are coming out and spending a lot of time with us now (day 3).

They like sleeping in bed with us. Heather LOVES all kinds of soft things to lie on...she made herself at home on her own pillow on day one and two where Lee and I put our heads. She lies right between us!

They are still a bit scared when they hear sudden noises. We expect them to continue to settle in and enjoy themselves more and more as the days go on. Lee comes home early each day also and has been spending time talking with them and petting them! We are so in love with their gentle and loving spirits and love them sooo much!

We are so happy to have had a chance to visit with you and all the kitties. It's an amazing sanctuary. We can tell that you all love what you do as these kitties are so precious and they know you love them and respect their lives!" Deneen and Lee Sakugawa

We are waiting on vet confirmation for the months of July and August.
